

## OAG ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

This policy applies to the business activities related to the products and services undertaken by OAG and its construction sites.

OAG Ltd. is committed to the continual improvement of our environmental management system to enhance our environmental performance through the support and involvement of all employees, suppliers and sub-contractors.

We shall ensure that our business activities comply with all relevant environmental legislation and fulfil our compliance obligations.

We are committed to the protection of the environment by seeking opportunities to manage and minimise our impact on the natural environment through:

- **mitigating Climate Change** by decreasing our Carbon Footprint and greenhouse gas emissions as a direct result of our business operations, including the manufacture, delivery and installation of our products;
- **minimising pollution** of the air, land and water through implementing preventative and reduction measures;
- **improving the responsible and sustainable procurement of materials and products** with reduced environmental impacts and responsible sourcing certifications; procuring timber for permanent works from FSC<sup>®</sup>, or PEFC, Chain of Custody certified sources; and improving procurement of other timber-based products;
- **reducing material waste** by implementing the waste hierarchy across our operations to minimise the amount of waste created; re-use products and materials where possible; and improve the sorting and recycling of remaining waste;
- **reducing the use of harmful chemicals** and seeking alternative products with lower environmental impacts during product manufacture and installation;
- **improving staff awareness** of environmental and sustainability issues relevant to the construction industry through providing, and encouraging access to, relevant training.

Our environmental performance shall be measured and monitored against annual targets in order to demonstrate progress towards our management system objectives.

This policy shall be reviewed annually and communicated to all employees including being publicly available to all interested parties via the OAG Ltd. website.
